Dear Resident, Family Member, and/or Legal Representative:

Today we were informed of a Long Term Care (LTC) staff member who tested positive for COVID-19.

Resident safety is our top priority. We are doing everything we can to ensure we prevent the spread of COVID-19 within our LTC facility. We are in very close communication with local and state health officials to ensure we are taking all the appropriate measures of prevention.

We continue to monitor and follow CDC recommended guidelines to prevent the transmission of any communicable illness, including COVID-19. Following state recommendations, we are testing all LTC staff and residents beginning immediately for COVID-19. Daily health screens including temperature checks for all residents and staff are being completed as we closely monitor all for any sign of viral illness. Our instruction for employees requires that they stay home if they feel ill. We continue to have strict visitation restrictions as well to further our prevention efforts.
